

CHANGES OF SOP

Starting from 1/5/2022, SMC will adopt the following SOP:-

a) Who can come?

- ALL parishioners (including non-vaccinated) can come to church for Masses / activities, except those who are COVID positive and under Home Surveillance Order

CHANGES OF SOP

- Those who are not well & children who can't wear facemasks indoors are encouraged to stay home

b) Wearing facemasks

- compulsory indoors in any building in the church compound
- encouraged outdoors in the church compound

CHANGES OF SOP

c) MySejahtera usage

- Parishioners **NEED NOT** scan MySejahtera, but still need to show MySejahtera status for wardens to check before entering the church

CHANGES OF SOP

d) Physical distancing

- No longer required if facemasks are worn in the church / building
- Parishioners are encouraged to sit with their family to minimise the risk and maximise church capacity

CHANGES OF SOP

The following SOPs will continue to be practised:

- Parishioners without MySejahtera will continue to write down their details for recording purposes.
- Sanitise hands before entering the church
- Sanitisation after Mass / activities
